

MUDDY CREEK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS April 21, 2021 7:00 PM

<u>CALL TO ORDER</u>: The Muddy Creek Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mr. Kerr. Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Mr. Saunders introduced Ms. Marissa Rasp as the new Secretary/Treasurer.

ROLL CALL: Those present included Mr. Dale Kerr, Mr. Rick Saunders, Mr. Robert Jesteadt, Mr. Thomas Smith, Mrs. Kelly Livermore, and Ms. Marissa Rasp was present.

NOTICE OF RECORDING POLICY: Mr. Kerr requested for anyone in the meeting to acknowledge the use of a recording device. No one acknowledged a recording device.

Mr. Joe Nash introduced himself as the candidate running for Magisterial District Judge.

Dorothy and Nathan Nye: A motion was made by Mr. Saunders to approve the non-building waiver plan with 10 ft. contours and the final plan contingent upon review of the planning commission. Seconded by Mr. Jesteadt. All in favor. Motion carried.

Mega Truck Stop: Mr. Larry Cable presented the final land development plan. A request was made by the Board to add a pedestrian crosswalk: additionally, an emergency generator was also requested. A motion was made by Mr. Saunder and seconded by Mr. Jesteadt to conditionally approve the plan with the following conditions:

- 1. Plan revised showing pedestrian crosswalk per review by the township engineer.
- 2. Approval by PA DEP for tap into the Lake Arthur Estates sewage system.
- 3. Traffic signal agreement between property owner and Muddy Creek Township.
- 4. Execution of a developers agreement.

If the conditions are completed prior to the May 19, 2021 Board of Supervisors meeting, the plan and traffic signal plan can be signed outside of the meeting. All in favor. Motion carried.

ROAD DEPARTMENT REPORT:

<u>Bauder School Road Pipe damage</u>: A motion was made by Mr. Saunders to send a Certified letter to the property owner identifying the damage repair and cost giving 30 days to remit payment or come to the next meeting to make payment of \$701.03. Mr. Kerr seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

<u>Bond Burnside Road</u>: A motion was made by Mr. Saunders to send a Certified letter to the property owner in regards to the use of the driveway stating the driveway needs to be moved or turned into a right in/right out driveway and that as of now, the permit is rescinded. It can no longer be used until they contact the township with a plan or the contractor utilizing the road must obtain a road bond for the road. Mr. Kerr seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

<u>Flinner Road</u> – A motion was made by Dale Kerr to send a certified letter to the property owners to inform them the road department repaired the roadway and driveway to divert storm water runoff. It is the property owners responsibility to maintain the driveway. The board needs to determine the cost of repair completed by road department.
