ROAD DEPARTMENT REPORT:

- A. <u>Red Truck:</u> The truck was listed on Municibid. No bid received. A motion to repost on Municibid using the recommendations of the Municibid manager. Second by Mr. Jesteadt. All in favor. Motion carried.
- B. <u>Road Damage:</u> CJ Long repaired the road.
- C. <u>Bauder Mill Road:</u> Bridge Damage. Contact the county bridge engineer. There is property on Bauder Mill Rod that has a 12" pipe that is not sufficient to handle the water flow. The engineer did inspect and made recommendations. The cost for the installation of a new 24" pipe next to the 12" pipe with a storm water catch basin will be approximately \$5200.00.
- D. Logging Over Posted Weight Permit: SES Wood Products bonded a portion of Kirk from Edna Lane to Stone Church, Stone Church, and Yellow Creek. SES is complete with logging. The logger for James Property will bond the roads separate. \$12,500 per mile
- E. <u>Driveway Permit:</u> Ralph Porter applied for a driveway permit for West Park Road. The engineer did get a chance to inspect and approved the site distance. The driveway is going to be steep and the engineer recommended that Mr. Porter meet with the road dept to address the water runoff.
- F. <u>Culvert Request:</u> Mr. Guillard at 228 Sawyer Road wants a culvert pipe installed along the front of his property. The engineer does not recommend this.
- G. Kelner Road: The private lane was paved. The owner needs to obtain a driveway permit.
- H. Road Occupancy Permit: Mark West (Gas line) on Hufnagel Road
- I. <u>Over Posted Weight Permit</u>: Mark West: Hufnagel, Bauder School and Pfiefer to Bauder School for pipeline installation. Bond \$12,500 per mile
- J. <u>Final Payment</u>: Youngblood Paving completed the paving project. Mr. Knapko completed the final inspection paperwork. A motion to approve the completion and release payment was made by Mr. Saunders. Second by Mr. Jesteadt. All I favor. Motion carried.
