Mr. Smith explained that a resolution can be changed with a majority vote of the supervisors. Mr. Saunders reported that it is his desire to spend the money in the building fund on a township building unless a catastrophic event would take place. It is noted for the record that Mr. Gramz requested for the money in the Building Fund is used exclusively for a township building.
- D. <u>Waste Management Hauler</u>: Mr. Kerr has requested that the township investigate the use of one hauler in Muddy Creek Township limited to residential waste.

SOLICITORS COMMENTS:

A. <u>Kelner Appeal</u>: The appeal resulted in a two to one vote in favor of the township. There is 30 day appeal period.

- A. <u>Website</u>: Mr. Saunders mentioned that the township website needs to be updated.
- B. <u>Water:</u> Mrs. Livermore requested for approval to contact Lou Negley to get a water cooler and water delivery in the administrative office.
